Your New Lawn care Instructions

HYDROSEEDING

Your grass seed has been applied with water and a slurry mix of goodies to protect and enhance your grass seed performance.

Care should be taken to establish your new lawn and its root base. As your grass matures it will become healthy and hard wearing, the gaps will fill out and the colour, a strong bold green, will develop. Avoid walking across the lawn for the first 3 weeks after hydroseeding and don't let animals onto the lawn over this time.

Allow 6 to 8 months for the grass to mature. Do not cut below 50mm height during this period. Mowing heights and when to mow after germination, will be advised after the 3 or 6 week assessment.

Care must be taken not to over or under water your lawn 3 to 6 weeks after hydroseeding as the ground will be new and will take time to settle. Water according to soil saturation rates, it is best to lightly dampen seedbed daily unless there is natural rainfall.

Bird distractors can be installed and can be as simple as stakes in the ground with tinfoil or plastic bags attached. Sprinklers should also be installed. Install both devices once the ground is dry and can be walked on with flat-soled shoes, this must be done within 3 days of hydroseeding.

Annual Lawn care (maintenance)

- Fertilise with slow release fertilisers during the months of March/ April and September to November.
- Treat weeds in Autumn and Spring, either remove by hand or use a recommended herbicide
- Mowing heights should never be below 25 mm. Keep lawn height between 25 to 50mm to maintain a healthy lawn. If lawn gets excessively long, reduce grass height gradually over several mows.
